SLAG Bylaws

1. Open Enrollment - New members are always welcome. We just ask that you make a commitment to SLAG
2. Members are required to attend ~~seven~~ six meetings a year (excused absence accepted with phone call) and at least one fundraising event to stay on the mailing list, get phone calls and take part in SLAG activities. Those members who are absent from meetings for three months in a row will be taken off the mailing list.
3. Officers will be elected at the May meeting. Officers must be in High School and have been a SLAG member for at least one year. Representatives from grades 7 and 8 will be elected and will advise officers.
4. Decisions (activities, funds designated, etc.) made be made with at least 7 members or three officers
5. Meetings are held the first Thursday of the month at 4:00. They will last approximately one hour. Committee Meetings (as needed) will be held the Tuesday following the SLAG Meeting.
6. SLAG Members are asked to follow the SLAG Meeting Etiquette rules
 - a. To speak raise your hand and address the president
 - b. Please respond to the SLAG sign for silence (Sign language b)
 - c. Talking is permitted during social time.
 - d. Members may be asked to leave if they cannot be quiet.
